A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept program year 2014 Home Weatherization Assistance Program awards of federal funds from the U.S. Department of Energy, in the amount of \$267,434.00, and from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, in the amount of \$709,251.00, for the program period 7/1/14 through 6/30/15, in the total amount of \$976,685.00, with no local cash match requirement, and appropriating grant funds, for the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development has been awarded federal funds in a Home Weatherization Assistance Program ("HWAP") for program year 2014, from the U.S. Department of Energy ("DOE"), in the amount of \$267,434.00, and from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services ("HHS"), in the total amount of \$709,251.00, for a total of \$976,685.00, with no local cash match requirement; and

WHEREAS, appropriations are required for HWAP expenditures within the guidelines of the DOE and HHS programs; and

WHEREAS, the HWAP funds annually help to provide necessary home improvements to low income citizens of the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the awards of the aforementioned program year 2014 HWAP funds from the DOE and HHS and to appropriate these grant funds;
