WHEREAS, the County of Summit Developmental Disabilities Board ("DD Board") and the DD Board wishes to enter into a one-year policing contract with the County of Summit to provide three County Sheriff's Deputies and three one-third shifts of a vehicle, for the period 6/1/14 through 5/31/15; and

WHEREAS, the DD Board has agreed to pay the County the amount of \$24,803.63 per month, for total of \$297,643.52, for the period 6/1/14 through 5/31/15, and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned policing contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a one-year policing contract with the County of Summit Developmental Disabilities Board ("DD Board"), to provide three Sheriff's Deputies and three one-third shifts of a vehicle, for the period 6/1/14 through 5/31/15, for the amount of \$297,643.52. The DD Board has agreed to pay the County the amount of \$24,803.63 per month, for a total amount of \$297,643.52 for the one-year term of the policing contract.

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately providing necessary policing to County of Summit Developmental Disabilities Board effective 6/1/14.
