7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control for the renewal (second of two)**  
8 **of an intergovernmental agreement with the Court of Common Pleas Juvenile Division, for**  
9 **Guardian Ad Litem services, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in an amount not to**  
10 **exceed \$271,398.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and**  
11 **declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 13, 2014, awarded the  
14 renewal (second of two) an intergovernmental agreement with the Court of Common Pleas  
15 Juvenile Division, for Guardian Ad Litem services, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15,  
16 subject to confirmation by County Council; and,

18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
19 that the renewal is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
22 of Ohio, that:

26 The award by the Board of Control for the renewal (second of two) of an  
27 intergovernmental agreement with the Court of Common Pleas Juvenile Division, for Guardian  
28 Ad Litem services, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in an amount not to exceed  
29 \$271,398.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such  
30 agreement renewal.

34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
36 provide Guardian Ad Litem services effective 10/1/14.

38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
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


