A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services, of a Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Law Enforcement Liaison grant for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in the amount of \$89,402.57, with no local cash match requirement, appropriating said grant funds, in the amount of \$89,402.57, for the period 10/1/14 through 12/31/14, and confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Richard Beverley, as Sole Source, for law enforcement liaison services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in an amount not to exceed \$85,090.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff has been an ongoing recipient of the State of Ohio's Law Enforcement Liaison Grant funds, from Ohio Department of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services("ODPS/OCJS"), which supports a contracted liaison officer to provide the County with technical assistance in achieving Ohio's goals and objectives in highway safety; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has received an award of a Federal Fiscal Year ("FFY") 2015 Law Enforcement Liaison Grant from ODPS/OCJS for the period 10/1/14 to 9/30/15, in the amount of \$89,402.57, with no local cash match requirement; and
