7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of two) of**  
8 **a professional service contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio (Express Scripts) to serve as**  
9 **the pharmacy benefits manager and to operate the mail-order pharmacy program on**  
10 **behalf of the County, for a one-year term, from 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, at an**  
11 **administrative cost of not to exceed \$0.75 per prescription, for the Executive's Department**  
12 **of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Amended Resolution No. 2012-379, which  
15 authorized the County Executive to execute a contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio ("Medco"),  
16 subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to serve as the County's pharmacy benefits  
17 manager and to administer a mail-order prescription program on behalf of the County, for a one-  
18 year term, from 1/1/13 through 12/31/13, with two options to renew for an additional one-year  
19 term; and

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21 WHEREAS, Medco was purchased by Express Scripts in 2012; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2013-380, which  
24 confirmed an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract renewal (first of  
25 two) with Medical Mutual of Ohio (Express Scripts) to serve as the pharmacy benefits manager  
26 and to operate the mail-order pharmacy program on behalf of the County, for a one-year term,  
27 from 1/1/14 through 12/31/14, at an administrative cost not to exceed \$0.75 per prescription; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting on September 10, 2014, awarded a  
30 professional service contract renewal (second of two) with Medical Mutual of Ohio (Express  
31 Scripts) to serve as the County's pharmacy benefits manager and to operate a mail-order  
32 pharmacy on behalf of the County, for a one-year term, from 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, at an  
33 administrative cost not to exceed \$0.75 per prescription subject to confirmation by County  
34 Council; and

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36 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
37 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to approve the renewal;

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39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
40 State of Ohio, that:

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44 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of two) of a professional service  
45 contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio (Express Scripts) to serve as the pharmacy benefits  
46 manager and to operate the mail-order pharmacy program on behalf of the County, for a one-year  
47 term, from 1/1/15 through 12/31/15, at an administrative cost not to exceed \$0.75 per  
48 prescription, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is authorized to execute such renewal.

4 SECTION 2

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
7 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately enter  
8 into said renewal (second of two) of a professional service contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio  
9 so that the County has a pharmacy benefits manager and mail-order pharmacy in place when the  
10 current term expires on 12/31/14.

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12 SECTION 3

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14 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
15 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
16 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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20 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
21 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
22 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
