## SECTION 1

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The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first and only) of a professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center to assist two-parent households in meeting mandated Ohio Works First work participation requirements, for the period 10/1/14 through 9/30/15, in an amount not to exceed \$64,541.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract renewal.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to provide assistance to two-parent households in meeting mandated Ohio Works First work participation requirements effective 10/1/14.

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
