A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc., for engineering and design services for the Home Avenue Bridge Replacement Project over the Little Cuyahoga River, in Council District 2, in an amount not to exceed \$473,446.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 29, 2014, awarded a professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc., for engineering and design services for the Home Avenue Bridge Replacement Project (No. AKR-011-0002) over the Little Cuyahoga River (SUM-CR 11-0.02; PID 97165), in Council District 2, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc., for engineering and design services for the Home Avenue Bridge Replacement Project (No. AKR-011-0002) over the Little Cuyahoga River (SUM-CR 11-0.02; PID 97165), in Council District 2, in an amount not to exceed \$473,446.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for the design phase of the project in Council District 2.
