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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with**
8 **Smith's Detection, Inc., for a hazardous materials gas chromatograph mass spectrometer,**
9 **in an amount not to exceed \$150,724.00, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance**
10 **and Risk Management – Division of Public Safety/Emergency Management, and declaring**
11 **an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 29, 2014, awarded a
14 purchase order with Smith's Detection, Inc., for a hazardous materials gas chromatograph mass
15 spectrometer, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that the purchase order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
21 of Ohio, that:

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23 SECTION 1

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25 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Smith's Detection, Inc., for a
26 hazardous materials gas chromatograph mass spectrometer, in an amount not to exceed
27 \$150,724.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such
28 purchase order.

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30 SECTION 2

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32 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
33 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
34 provide the hazardous materials gas chromatograph mass spectrometer in 2014.

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36 SECTION 3

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38 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
39 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
40 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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42 SECTION 4

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44 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
45 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
46 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
47 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
48 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
