A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute Amendment #1 to a subgrant agreement, as a representative of Workforce Investment Act Local Area 2, with the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services and the Medina County Department of Job and Family Services, for a Workforce Investment Act Local Area 2 grant for Workforce Investment Act Disability Employment Initiative funds, to extend the subgrant agreement through 12/31/14, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code provides, commencing 7/1/08, that the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("Ohio DJFS") may only make grants to counties through subgrant agreements as described in that Section; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, Ohio DJFS developed a standard subgrant agreement to be executed by the commissioners of each county prior to receiving Ohio DJFS grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Department of Job and Family Services ("Summit DJFS") and the Medina County Department of Job and Family Services ("Medina DJFS") have previously executed the subgrant agreement for the Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") Local Area 2's routine WIA funds for the period 7/1/11 through 6/30/13; and

WHEREAS, Ohio DJFS notified Summit DJFS and Medina DJFS that WIA Local Area 2 would be the recipient of \$6,967.00 annually in WIA Disability Employment Initiative ("WIA DEI") funds, and has requested that Summit DJFS and Medina DJFS execute a subgrant agreement governing receipt of those funds during the period 1/1/12 through 9/30/14; and

WHEREAS, County Council adopted Resolution No. 2012-185, which authorized the County Executive to execute a subgrant agreement, as a representative of Local Area 2, with the Ohio DJFS and Medina DJS for a WIA Local Area 2 grant for WIA DEI funds, during the period of 1/1/12 through 9/30/14; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Labor ("USDOL" has offered Ohio an opportunity to continue operating the WIAD DEI for three additional months, through 12/31/14, a no-cost extension which allows Ohio to complete some of the project activities and to spend the remaining funds; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of USDOL's formal approval of the no-cost extension, Ohio DJFS, Summit DJFS and Medina DJFS wish to execute Amendment #1 to the subgrant agreement to extend the subgrant agreement through 12/31/14; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute Amendment #1 to the aforementioned subgrant agreement to extend the subgrant agreement through 12/31/14;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute Amendment #1 to a subgrant agreement, as a representative of Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") Local Area 2, with Ohio DJFS and Medina DJFS governing the receipt of WIA Disability Employment Initiative funds by WIA Local Area 2 during the period of January 1, 2012 through September 30, 2014. A copy of said Amendment #1 to the subgrant agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately execute said Amendment #1 to the subgrant agreement so that the subgrant agreement may be extended through 12/31/14.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and shall be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
