WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 19, 2014, awarded a purchase contract with Emerson Network Power, under State Term Pricing, to provide preventative maintenance for the County Fiscal Office's Uninterruptable Power Supply Systems and Sealed Battery Systems for server hardware protection, for a one-year term, from 1/27/15 through 1/26/16, in an amount not to exceed \$28.770.04, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
