WHEREAS, on November 13, 2014, the Planning Commission approved the plat for the subdivision titled "Natures Preserve Phase 3," concerning a subdivision located in Twinsburg Township; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the acceptance and approval of the aforementioned replat is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

SECTION 1

SECTION 2

The following maintenance bond furnished by American Contractors Indemnity Company in the amount of \$ 54,813.00, having been submitted and approved, was accepted in conjunction with "Natures Preserve Phase 3." The documents are to be retained by the County Executive, who is authorized to release said bond, in part or in full, upon satisfactory completion of the obligations set forth.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately facilitates development in Twinsburg Township.
