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8 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a collective bargaining**
9 **agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 (Office and Clerical) of the American**
10 **Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the County**
11 **Executive and County Sheriff, for the period 4/1/14 through 3/31/17, for the Executive and**
12 **the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between the County
15 Executive and County Sheriff and Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 (Office and Clerical) of the
16 American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, for the period
17 4/1/14 through 3/31/17; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
20 that the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement is necessary and in the best interest of
21 the County of Summit and the County Executive should be authorized to execute said collective
22 bargaining agreement;

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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement
30 between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 (Office and Clerical) of the American Federation of
31 State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the County Executive and County
32 Sheriff, for the period 4/1/14 through 3/31/17.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of providing a
38 timely collective bargaining agreement between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1229 (Office and
39 Clerical) of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and
40 the County Executive and County Sheriff.

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
