7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, to**
8 **execute a Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Agreement with Access, Inc. to provide**
9 **homeless prevention services, for the period 1/1/22 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to**
10 **exceed \$100,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services desires to enter into
14 a Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") Agreement with Access, Inc. to provide
15 homeless prevention services for homeless women and children; and

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17 WHEREAS, services will include emergency shelter stays averaging from 30 to 45 days
18 per family; and

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20 WHEREAS, shelter stays will include a range of services to assist families in attaining,
21 and maintaining permanent housing including case management, life management, health and
22 wellness classes and aftercare services; and

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24 WHEREAS, a TANF Agreement with Access, Inc. for the aforementioned homeless
25 prevention services, for the period 1/1/22 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed
26 \$100,000.00, will be presented to the Board of Control for approval at its meeting to be held on
27 January 5, 2022; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
30 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit, to authorize the Executive to
31 execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, the aforementioned TANF Agreement
32 with Access, Inc.;

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34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
35 of Ohio, that:

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37 SECTION 1

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39 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of
40 Control, a Temporary Assistance for Needy Families ("TANF") Agreement and any necessary
41 related documents with Access, Inc. to provide homeless prevention services for homeless
42 women and children, for the period 1/1/22 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed
43 \$100,000.00.

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45 SECTION 2

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47 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
48 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
49 authorizes a necessary TANF Agreement that will provide services to homeless women and
50 children in Summit County.
