DESCRIPTION NO. 2022 021

A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control for an extension of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which shall include the operation of the County of Summit Community Alternative Sentencing Center (CS-CASC), for a one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22, in an amount not to exceed \$6,946,915.68, for the Executive's Department of Public Safety and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-433, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for day reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration, multiple offender, pretrial services and residential community corrections programs for the period 1/1/17 through 12/31/17, in an amount not to exceed \$5,921,097.39, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, with the cost of any renewal term to be equal to the increase in the Consumer Price Index or three percent, whichever is less; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-026, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control for a renewal (first of four) of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, for a one-year term from 1/1/18 through 12/31/18, in an amount not to exceed \$5,921,097.39; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-360, which repealed Ordinance No. 83-406 and 96-611 designating 40 East Glenwood Avenue, Akron, Ohio 44304 as a County Jail Facility and pursuant to Section 307.932 of the Ohio Revised Code redesignated and established 40 East Glenwood Avenue as the County of Summit Community Alternative Sentencing Center (CA-CASC); and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-359, which authorized the Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, a renewal (second of four) of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which included the operation of the CS-CASC, for a one-year term from 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in an amount not to exceed \$6,571,493.73; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2020-051, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control for a renewal (third of four) of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which included the operation of the CS-CASC, for a one-year term from 1/1/20 through 12/31/20, in an amount not to exceed \$6,946,915.68; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-005, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control for a final renewal (four of four) of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which included the operation of the CS-CASC, for a one-year term from 1/1/21 through 12/31/21, in an amount not to exceed \$6,946,915.68; and

WHEREAS, the County is in the process of implementing various technology projects to assist in creating and improving efficiencies throughout the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, due to the pending technology outcomes for the criminal justice system, the Executive wishes to extend the current professional services agreement with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which shall continue to include the operation of the CS-CASC for a one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held January 19, 2022, awarded the aforementioned professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections program services, including the operation of the CS-CASC, subject to the confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned extension of the professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc., which shall include the operation of the CS-CASC, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control for an extension of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which shall include the operation of the County of Summit Community Alternative Sentencing Center (CS-CASC), for a one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22, in an amount not to exceed \$6,946,915.68 is hereby approved and the Executive is authorized to execute said professional services contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive to continue to contract for community corrections services.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
