This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents and employees of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to immediately create the non-bargaining, unclassified positions of Director and Fiscal Officer/General Counsel to mirror job duties of those positions in the Executive's and the Engineer's offices and establish a pay schedule in order to successfully retain personnel within the Fiscal Office.

SECTION 6

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 7
