7 **An amended Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept various grants from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice**  
9 **Assistance Affairs, for Court of Common Pleas programs, in the amounts set forth in a**  
10 **total amount of \$1,725,000.00, with a total local cash match requirement of \$533,333.32**  
11 **\$441,666.66, for the Court of Common Pleas – General Division, and declaring an**  
12 **emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, through the Bureau of Justice  
15 Assistance Affairs, has awarded a grant to the Court of Common Pleas – General Division for  
16 the Turning Point Program, for the period 10/1/21 through 9/30/25, in the amount of  
17 \$550,000.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$183,333.33 ~~\$137,500.00~~; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the Turning Point Program, which is presided over by Judge Joy Malek  
20 Oldfield, is an Ohio Supreme Court certified specialized docket which serves residents of  
21 Summit County by providing effective court-supervision and enhanced treatment services for  
22 substance dependent adult felony offenders; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, through the Bureau of Justice  
25 Assistance Affairs, has awarded a grant to the Court of Common Pleas – General Division for  
26 the HOPE Mental Health Court Point Program, for the period 10/1/21 through 9/30/25, in the  
27 amount of \$550,000.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$183,333.33 ~~\$137,500.00~~;

30 WHEREAS, the HOPE Mental Health Court Point Program Point Program, which is  
31 presided over by Judge Alison Breaux, is an Ohio Supreme Court certified specialized docket  
32 which serves adult offenders with persistent and severe mental illness; and

34 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, through the Bureau of Justice  
35 Assistance Affairs, has awarded a grant to the Court of Common Pleas – General Division for  
36 the Valor Court, for the period 10/1/21 through 9/30/25, in the amount of \$625,000.00, with a  
37 local cash match requirement of \$166,666.66; and

38  
39 WHEREAS, the Valor Court, which is presided over by Judge Amy Corrigan Jones, is an  
40 Ohio Supreme Court certified specialized docket and veteran's treatment court serving veterans  
41 involved in Summit County's adult criminal justice system; and

42  
43 WHEREAS, the aforementioned grants will fund the Court of Common Pleas – General  
44 Division programs and activities set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and  
45 incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

47 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
48 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
49 execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grants from the United States  
50 Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance Affairs, and to authorize the expenditure of  
51 the cash match requirements in the amounts set forth in Exhibit A;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
5 of Ohio, that:

7 SECTION 1

8  
9 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the  
10 grants in the amounts from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance  
11 Affairs set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as if fully  
12 restated. The expenditure of the cash match requirement amounts for each grant as set forth in  
13 Exhibit A is hereby authorized.

15 SECTION 2

17 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare  
18 of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing  
19 the acceptance of necessary grants to provide additional services to substance dependent adult  
20 felony offenders in Summit County.

22 SECTION 3

24 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
25 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
26 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

30 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
31 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
32 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
33 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
34 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


