A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Barbicas Construction Company, Inc. for the 2022 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-North, in an amount not to exceed \$2,930,214.50, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-388, which authorized the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2022 Capital Improvements Program, and federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$12,724,400.00; and

WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program for 2022-2027 by Resolution No. 2022-032; and

WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive has proposed entering into a construction contract with Barbicas Construction Company, Inc. for the 2022 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-North, in an amount not to exceed \$2,930,214.50; and
