A Resolution ratifying the Executive's execution of a lease agreement with the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments, for 1,350 square feet of office space located at 175 South Main Street, Akron, Ohio 44308, in Council District 4, for a five-year term, from 4/1/20 through 3/31/25, in the amount of \$5,400.00 per year, with one option to renew for an additional two-year term, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-043, which authorized the Executive to execute a five-year lease agreement with Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments ("SAMWA-COG"), for approximately 1641 square feet of office space located at 191 South Main Street, Akron, Ohio 44308, in Council District 4, for the period 3/1/17 through 2/28/22, in the amount of \$1.00 per year, with one option to renew for an additional five-year term.

WHEREAS, the Executive determined that there was 1,350 square feet of office space located on the second floor of 175 South Main Street, Akron, Ohio 44308, in Council District 4, and that it would be appropriate for use by the SAMWA-COG for general office use; and

WHEREAS, the Executive and the SAMWA-COG entered into a lease agreement for that space in April of 2020, with rent in the amount of \$450.00 per month, or \$5,400.00 per year, with one option to renew for an additional two-year term and which included additional rent for the purpose of completing renovations to the space in the amount of \$6,048.95 (the "Lease"); and

WHEREAS, the Lease was then amended on 4/1/2021 to remove the requirement of additional rent as the SAMWA-COG had paid for the renovations but with no change to other terms; and

WHEREAS, the Executive and the SAMWA-COG executed the Lease and the amendment, and it is necessary for this Council to ratify the Executive's execution of the Lease and amendment; and

WHEREAS, SAMWA-COG, is a council of governments that is responsible for implementing, governing, and administering all workforce development programming, as permitted under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act ("WIOA"), in Summit and Medina Counties; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 177.17(e) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, this Council must approve any lease of County-owned property to a governmental entity; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to ratify the Executive's execution of the Lease;
