An Ordinance amending Chapter 942 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Surface Water Management District," to revise the billing procedure in Section 942.06, entitled "Schedule of Fees and Charges," and Section 942.07, entitled "Billing and Collection," for the purpose of streamlining the billing process and reducing administrative costs, for the Executive and the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously enacted Chapter 942 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Surface Water Management District," to create an opt-in voluntary surface water management district (the "District") for the townships and municipalities in the County; and

WHEREAS, Bath Township opted to join the District, and the Engineer is currently operating the District within Bath Township; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit has various permit requirements for Phase 2 of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") which are set forth in Title 40, Part 122 of the Federal Code of Regulations; and

WHEREAS, because the District's work is being performed to meet said NPDES requirements, Ohio Revised Code Section 6117.02(D), which authorizes rates and charges to be paid annually or semiannually with real property taxes, applies to the District; and

WHEREAS, under the current billing process, a non-exempt property is annually billed a Surface Water Management Service Charge of \$4.00 per month, or at a rate otherwise set by this Council, for each Equivalent Rate Unit ("ERU") calculated by the Engineer to be assessed against that zoned lot or tract; and

WHEREAS, assessing said ERU through real property taxes in District communities will streamline the billing process and reduce administrative costs; and

WHEREAS, in order to revise the District's billing process, it will be necessary to amend Section 942.06, entitled "Schedule of Fees and Charges," and Section 942.07, entitled "Billing and Collection,"; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary to amend Chapter 942 for the aforementioned reason;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Summit County and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately amend Chapter 942 in order to streamline the billing process and reduce administrative costs.
