A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an agreement with HLF Enterprises, LLC for the acquisition of a permanent easement on Permanent Parcel No. 5609658, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, for a total amount not to exceed \$2,125.00, as part of the Pump Station 19 Relocation Project Q-452, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the acquisition of a permanent easement is necessary for the continuation of the Pump Station 19 Relocation Project Q-452 (the "Project"), located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, Black & Veatch and their subcontractor, O.R. Colan Associates, on behalf of the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, have determined and negotiated the amount of a permanent easement for Permanent Parcel No. 5609658, which is real property owned by HLF Enterprises, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$2,125.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned agreement for the acquisition of a permanent easement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for the acquisition of a permanent easement for Permanent Parcel No. 5609658 with HLF Enterprises, LLC, the owner of said property, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, in an amount not to exceed \$2,125.00, as part of the Pump Station 19 Relocation Project Q-452.

## SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes the execution of the aforementioned agreement for the acquisition of an easement so that the Pump Station 19 Relocation Project Q-452 may continue to its conclusion.

## SECTION 3

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Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
