RESOLUTION NO. 2022-124

A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, of a purchase contract with Data Cloud Solutions-A Woolpert Company, as a Best Practical Source, for MobileAssessor hardware and software to enable Fiscal Office appraisers to digitally reappraise real property in real time, for a term from 4/8/22 through 12/31/28, for a total amount not to exceed \$679,946.24, for the Fiscal Officer and the Office of Information Technology, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, currently Fiscal Office appraisers complete work in the field on paper which is turned into the data entry department to be entered in the Computer Assisted Mass Appraisal ("CAMA") system; and

WHEREAS, Data Cloud Solutions-A Woolpert Company ("Data Cloud Solutions") can provide MobileAssessor software to enable the Fiscal Office appraisers, through the use of an iPad, to complete much of the entry in the field, eliminating work on paper which then eliminates duplicate data entry into the CAMA system; and

WHEREAS, using MobileAssessor, uploading photos, sketching, and evaluating new construction can all be done in real time, leading to increased efficiency and productivity; and

WHEREAS, MobileAssessor software can mitigate inefficiencies by providing better routing capabilities that minimize driving to the properties being appraised; and

WHEREAS, Lucas County saved 10,000 personnel hours by using MobileAssessor in its reappraisals; and

WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a purchase contract with Data Cloud Solutions for MobileAssessor hardware and software; and

WHEREAS, because MobileAssessor is easily integrated with IASWorld which the County currently uses, Data Cloud Solutions is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, and is exempt from competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on April 6, 2022, awarded, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, a purchase contract with Data Cloud Solutions, as a Best Practical Source, for MobileAssessor hardware and software to enable Fiscal Office appraisers to digitally reappraise real property in real time, for a term from 4/8/22 through 12/31/28, for a total amount not to exceed \$679,946.24, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of \$679,946.24 will be billed in three installments between the execution of the purchase contract and February 2023; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contract with Data Cloud Solutions is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, of a purchase contract with Data Cloud Solutions-A Woolpert Company for MobileAssessor hardware and software to enable Fiscal Office appraisers to digitally reappraise real property in real time, for a term from 4/8/22 through 12/31/28, for a total amount not to exceed \$679,946.24, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately provides for mobile reappraisal of County real property by the Fiscal Office.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
