7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**  
8 **construction contract with Workman Industrial Services, Inc. for the Miscellaneous**  
9 **Bridge/Culvert Repair Project to include repairing the Knox Boulevard Bridge, located in**  
10 **Copley Township, in Council District 5, in an amount not to exceed \$108,134.00 (for a**  
11 **cumulative increase of 42.8%), for a total amount not to exceed \$360,500.00, for the**  
12 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-416, which authorized  
15 the Executive to advertise for bids as necessary for bridge engineering and construction projects,  
16 pavement maintenance and federally funded projects for the Engineer's 2021 Capital  
17 Improvement Program, and federal and state funded projects at an estimated cost not to exceed  
18 \$9,117,500.00; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, the Executive was authorized by Resolution No. 2021-416 to advertise for  
21 bids for pavement, culvert, and ditch maintenance, in an amount not to exceed \$4,848,500.00, in  
22 2021; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, the Engineer proposed the Miscellaneous Bridge/Culvert Repairs Project  
25 (the "Project"), which would repair the culverts located in Council Districts 1, 6 and 7; and

26  
27 WHEREAS, after advertising for bids, the Executive received bids from five firms and  
28 selected Workman Industrial Services, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, to  
29 perform the work on the Project; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-005 which  
32 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Workman Industrial  
33 Services, Inc. for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$252,366.00; and

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35 WHEREAS, Knox Boulevard Bridge needs repair and the Engineer has determined that  
36 the best way to fix the structurally deficient, load limited bridge is to apply the same techniques  
37 used in the Project to extend the bridge's life and make it safe for emergency vehicle use; and

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39 WHEREAS, in order to employ most efficiently said techniques, the Engineer proposes  
40 expanding the scope of the Project to include the repair of the Knox Boulevard Bridge, which  
41 will require Change Order No. 1 to the contract with Workman Industrial Services, Inc.; and

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43 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 20, 2022, awarded Change  
44 Order No. 1 to the construction contract with Workman Industrial Services, Inc. for the Project to  
45 include repairing the Knox Boulevard Bridge, located in Copley Township, in Council District 5,  
46 in an amount not to exceed \$108,134.00 (for a cumulative increase of 42.8%), for a total amount  
47 not to exceed \$360,500.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

49 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
50 that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to the construction contract with Workman  
51 Industrial Services, Inc. for the Project is necessary and in the best interest of the County of  
52 Summit;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
5 of Ohio, that;

7 SECTION 1

8  
9 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a construction contract with  
10 Workman Industrial Services, Inc. for the Miscellaneous Bridge/Culvert Repair Project to  
11 include repairing the Knox Boulevard Bridge, located in Copley Township, in Council District 5,  
12 in an amount not to exceed \$108,134.00 (for a cumulative increase of 42.8%), for a total amount  
13 not to exceed \$360,500.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to  
14 execute said Change Order No. 1 and any other necessary related documents.

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16 SECTION 2

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18 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
19 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately provides  
20 for necessary repair of the Knox Boulevard Bridge in Council District 5.

22 SECTION 3

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24 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
25 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
26 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

27  
28 SECTION 4

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30 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
31 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
32 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
33 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
34 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


