7 **A Resolution revising the assessments for the parcels of the Dedication Plat of Columbia**
8 **Road & Allega Way, in Richfield Township, in Council District 1, for drainage**
9 **maintenance, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-256, which approved
12 and accepted the Dedication Plat of Columbia Road & Allega Way, in Richfield Township, in
13 Council District 1; and

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15 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-257, which levied
16 assessments for the on-going maintenance of a drainage system for the Dedication Plat of
17 Columbia Road & Allega Way, in Richfield Township, in Council District 1; and

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19 WHEREAS, the “Plat of Lot Split & Consolidation,” was recorded on March 16, 2022,
20 with Document # 56725379 concerning a resubdivision of land located in Richfield Township; in
21 Council District 1; and

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23 WHEREAS, said Dedication Plat of Columbia Road & Allega Way included a drainage
24 maintenance assessment provision signed by all owners of parcels located within said
25 subdivision, with said provision applying to subsequent owners of the same parcels; and

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27 WHEREAS, assessments for drainage maintenance also are permitted by Sections
28 6137.02 and 6137.03 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

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30 WHEREAS, the Engineer seeks to revise the assessments for drainage maintenance for
31 said subdivision and to fully execute his powers and duties thereof; and

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33 WHEREAS, the Engineer has prepared a revised special assessment worksheet, a copy of
34 which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein, which apportions necessary
35 charges for drainage maintenance among the subdivision’s benefited parcel owners; and

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37 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
38 that revising the assessments for the residents of the Dedication Plat of Columbia Road & Allega
39 Way in Richfield Township, in Council District 1, for drainage maintenance, per attached
40 Exhibit A, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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47 Drainage maintenance assessments for the Dedication Plat of Columbia Road & Allega
48 Way, in Richfield Township, in Council District 1, are hereby revised.

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4 SECTION 2

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6 Owners of parcels within the Dedication Plat of Columbia Road & Allega Way shall be
7 assessed for drainage maintenance, proportional to the estimated benefit to the respective parcel,
8 as set forth in the revised special assessment worksheet, a copy of which is attached hereto as
9 Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein.

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11 SECTION 3

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13 Pursuant to Section 6137.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Clerk of Council shall certify
14 the attached assessments to the Fiscal Officer for placement on the next succeeding tax duplicate
15 to be collected and paid.

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17 SECTION 4

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19 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
20 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately fund
21 necessary drainage maintenance in the Dedication Plat of Columbia Road & Allega Way in
22 Richfield Township, in Council District 1.

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26 Provided this resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
27 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
28 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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30 SECTION 6
