7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal of agreements**  
8 **(first of two) between certain providers and the Executive’s Department of Job and Family**  
9 **Services and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments, to provide**  
10 **in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services under the**  
11 **Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program, for the period 7/1/22 to**  
12 **6/30/23, in a total amount not to exceed \$2,038,005.49, for the Executive’s Department of**  
13 **Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, Ohio consolidated the delivery of Workforce Investment Opportunity Act  
16 (“WIOA”) and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (“TANF”) funded youth services  
17 under the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program (“CCMEP”); and

18  
19 WHEREAS, Ohio requires its Local Workforce Areas to work collaboratively with  
20 County Departments of Job and Family Services to administer CCMEP services; and

21  
22 WHEREAS, this Council, pursuant to Resolution No. 2021-182, awarded certain  
23 agreements to fulfill these obligations and such agreements contained two options to renew for  
24 an additional one year term; and

25  
26 WHEREAS, the CCMEP program provides employment and training services to low-  
27 income, in-school and out-of-school, youth aged 14 to 24, based on a comprehensive assessment  
28 of employment and training needs, as well as a basic skills assessment; and

29  
30 WHEREAS, CCMEP participants are provided services to support goals outlined in their  
31 Individual Opportunity Plan (“IOP”), which may include objectives, such as, obtaining a high  
32 school diploma, job placement, work experience and other identified supportive services, such  
33 as, childcare and transportation; and

34  
35 WHEREAS, CCMEP services are provided with the goals of assisting at-risk youth in  
36 achieving major educational goals, skill development and/or employment; and

37  
38 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 4, 2022, awarded a renewal  
39 (first of two) of the agreements between certain providers as set forth on Exhibit A, a copy of  
40 which is attached hereto and incorporated fully herein, and DJFS and the SAMWA COG to  
41 provide these services under the CCMEP for the period 7/1/22 to 6/30/23, in a total amount not  
42 to exceed \$2,038,005.49, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

44 WHEREAS, as required by the CCMEP, this renewal will be funded by both WIOA  
45 funding through the SAMWA COG and TANF funding through DJFS, with the TANF allocation  
46 being \$1,466,839.57; and

47  
48 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
49 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to approve the aforementioned  
50 renewal of these agreements with the providers listed on Exhibit A;

9 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) of agreements between  
10 certain providers set forth on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto as and incorporated  
11 fully herein, and the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services and the Summit and  
12 Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments to provide in-school and out-of-school youth  
13 employment and educational services under the Comprehensive Case Management and  
14 Employment Program, for the period 7/1/22 to 6/30/23, in a total amount not to exceed  
15 \$2,038,005.49, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said  
16 agreements and any other necessary related documents.

20 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
21 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
22 provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services effective 7/1/22.

26 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
27 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
28 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

32 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
33 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
34 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

36 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
