A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of three) of a professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. to perform in-depth bridge condition inspection services for the North Main Street Bridge over the Cuyahoga River, located in the City of Akron, in Council Districts 2 and 4, for a one-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$54,480.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the North Main Street Bridge over the Cuyahoga River, located in the City of Akron, in Council Districts 2 and 4, also known as the High Level Bridge, is Summit County's tallest and most complex bridge; and

WHEREAS, in addition to requiring specialized condition inspection services on the bridge because of its size and height, the bridge is also classified as "fracture critical" meaning there is no redundancy built into the structure; and

WHEREAS, because of this classification, the Engineer performs additional in-depth inspections every two years per Federal Highway Administration and Ohio Department of Transportation requirements which require more equipment and personnel and therefore have a much higher cost than a routine inspection. Such an in-depth inspection is required this year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Directive No. 159-21, the Board of Control awarded a professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc., which was selected by the Engineer as the highest technical evaluation score out of the seven firms that submitted proposals, for bridge condition inspection services for the North Main Street Bridge, for a one-year term, with three options to renew for an additional one-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$11,346.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 25, 2022, awarded a renewal (first of three) of a professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. to perform in-depth bridge condition inspection services for the North Main Street Bridge, for a one-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$54,480.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned renewal (first of three) of the professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
