7 **An Ordinance enacting Chapter 942 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit**
8 **entitled “Surface Water Management District,” for the Engineer and the Executive, and**
9 **declaring an emergency.**

10
11 WHEREAS, this Council, by Resolution No. 2019-283, established the Stormwater
12 Management Committee, in recognition of the importance of handling issues related to
13 stormwater runoff as well as water quality impact resulting therefrom; and

14
15 WHEREAS, this Council previously approved Resolution No. 2021-347, enacting
16 Chapter 944 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit entitled “Illicit Discharge
17 Detection and Elimination Program,” as set forth in Exhibit A to permit the Engineer to regulate
18 non-stormwater discharges to the storm water drainage system of the County; and

19
20 WHEREAS, as a result of meetings of that committee and the implementation of the
21 Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Program, further work has been done by the Engineer
22 and the Executive to determine the best way to regulate and fund activities and projects related to
23 water quality, surface water in general and stormwater runoff specifically; and

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25 WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the County to acquire, construct,
26 establish, enlarge, improve, maintain, own, operate, and contract for the operation of a public
27 enterprise to furnish service to the County and its residents and property owners to address water
28 quality as required under phase II of the storm water program of the national pollutant discharge
29 elimination system established in 40CFR Part 122; and

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31 WHEREAS, the Engineer and the Executive have determined that the adoption of an
32 ordinance that provides for guidelines and standards for the operation of a countywide Surface
33 Water Management District in the unincorporated political subdivisions of the County and in
34 those incorporated political subdivisions that have adopted legislation authorizing participation
35 under this Chapter is in the best interest of the County and in furtherance of the work of the
36 Stormwater Management Committee; and

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38 WHEREAS, the City of Reminderville, Village of Lakemore, Village of Clinton, and the
39 Village of Boston Heights are requesting to be included in the Service Area pursuant to
40 legislation adopted by each municipality and such approval by this Council is included in the
41 attached Ordinance; and

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43 WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Chapter, the Executive and the Engineer will begin to
44 assess potential projects and establish a prioritized list of projects that can be completed to
45 accomplish the goals of the Chapter and which can be funded initially with monies available to
46 the County through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, (“ARPA”) section 9901,
47 Pub.LNo.117-2 codified at 42 U.S.C. section 802 et seq., one purpose of which is to provide
48 funds to support stormwater related infrastructure projects, and which will thereafter be funded
49 by assessments received pursuant to the Ordinance; and

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4 WHEREAS, upon adoption of this Chapter, the Executive and the Engineer will also
5 begin to work with Summit Soil and Water and participating communities to implement the
6 Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Program and carry out the requirements of the
7 County's MS4 permit, issued by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency; and

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9 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
10 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to enact Chapter 942 of
11 Codified Ordinances for the reasons set forth above;

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13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
14 of Ohio, that:

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16 SECTION 1

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18 Chapter 942 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Surface
19 Water Management District," is hereby enacted as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and
20 incorporated herein by reference.

21
22 SECTION 2

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24 The participation of the City of Reminderville, Village of Lakemore, Village of Clinton,
25 and the Village of Boston Heights in the District is hereby explicitly approved.

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27 SECTION 3

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29 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
30 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
31 enacting Chapter 942 in order to permit the Sheriff to provide the required reports to Council at
32 the time the Sheriff makes a budget presentation.

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34 SECTION 4

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36 Provided this Ordinance received the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
37 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
38 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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40 SECTION 5

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42 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
43 to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
44 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
45 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
46 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

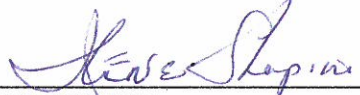
