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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract, subject**
8 **to approval of the Information Technology Board, with Cadenza, LLC. to provide fiber**
9 **and network equipment for the University of Akron Public Safety Monitoring Network,**
10 **located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, in an amount not to exceed \$99,767.38,**
11 **under the State of Ohio, OARnet pricing, a division of the Ohio Technology Consortium**
12 **(OH-TECH), for the Executive’s Department of Public Safety, and declaring an**
13 **emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, pursuant to cooperative agreement approved by this Council under
16 Resolution 2022-195 the County desires to invest a portion of the \$105 million it has received in
17 State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds from the American Rescue Plan Act, which amended
18 Title VI of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 801, et seq. to create Section 603 (“ARPA” and the
19 funds received by the County being the “ARPA Funds”) to be used pursuant to the ARPA and
20 the Final Rule adopted by the Department of Treasury, a public safety monitoring network in the
21 areas of Grant, Thornton, Exchange and Brown Streets, located in the City of Akron, in Council
22 District 4 to improve safety; and

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24 WHEREAS, the parties require fiber and network equipment to implement the project;
25 and

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27 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a professional services contract with
28 Cadenza, LLC. for the aforementioned project; and

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30 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 1, 2022, awarded a purchase
31 contract, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, with Cadenza, LLC. to
32 provide fiber and network equipment for the University of Akron Camera Project, in an amount
33 not to exceed \$99,767.38, under the State of Ohio, OARnet pricing, a division of the Ohio
34 Technology Consortium (OH-TECH), subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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36 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
37 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Cadenza, LLC. is necessary and in the best
38 interest of the County of Summit;

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40 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
41 of Ohio, that:

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45 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract, subject to the approval of the
46 Information Technology Board, with Cadenza, LLC. to provide fiber and network equipment for
47 the University of Akron Camera Project, in an amount not to exceed \$99,767.38, under the State
48 of Ohio, OARnet pricing, a division of the Ohio Technology Consortium (OH-TECH), is hereby
49 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute the above mentioned purchase
50 contract and any necessary related documents.

8 camera project prior to the return of students for the start of the 2022-2023 school year.
