7 **A Resolution approving the 2022 wage reopener as agreed between the County of Summit,**  
8 **Engineer and Local 1032 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal**  
9 **Employees, AFL-CIO (Service and Maintenance Unit), for the second year of the parties’**  
10 **collective bargaining agreement (4/1/22 through 3/31/23), for the Executive and the**  
11 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

12  
13 WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 2021-188 a collective bargaining agreement and  
14 memorandum of understanding was approved between Ohio Council 8 and Local 1032 (Service  
15 and Maintenance Unit) of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees,  
16 AFL-CIO (collectively, the “Union”), and the Executive and the Engineer, for the period 4/1/21  
17 through 3/31/24, with a reopener on wages in the second and third year of the agreement  
18 (4/1/2022 and 4/1/2023); and

20 WHEREAS, the Executive and the Union have reached an agreement on the 2022 wage  
21 reopener with an increase in pay of two and one-half percent (2.5%) in the second year of the  
22 agreement (effective 4/1/2022); and

23  
24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
25 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to approve the wage reopener between  
26 the Union and the Executive and the Engineer, as agreed between the parties;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
29 of Ohio, that:

31 SECTION 1

33 The agreement on the wage reopener between the Executive, the Engineer and Ohio  
34 Council 8 and Local 1032 (Service and Maintenance Unit) of the American Federation of State,  
35 County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, for the second year of the collective bargaining  
36 agreement, effective April 1, 2022, is hereby approved, authorizing an increase in pay of two and  
37 one-half percent (2.5%).

39 SECTION 2

41 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
42 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the for the further purpose of providing  
43 a timely wage increase for Local 1032 (Service and Maintenance Unit) of the American  
44 Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO.

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


