7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Kenmore Construction Co., Inc. for the Revere Road Bridge Design/Build Project, located**
9 **in Bath Township, in Council District 4, in an amount not to exceed \$583,862.52, for the**
10 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution 2021-388, which authorized the
13 Executive to advertise for bids for the Revere Road Bridge Design/Build Project (“Project”), as
14 part of bridge engineering and construction projects, and pavement maintenance projects, for the
15 Engineer’s 2022 Capital Improvements Program, and federal and state funded projects, for an
16 estimated total cost not to exceed \$12,724,400.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
19 for 2022-2027 by Resolution No. 2022-032; and

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21 WHEREAS, Revere Road Bridge over Revere Run, Bridge No. BAT-114-0320, on
22 Revere Road in Bath Township, was built in 1965. This will be a design-build project to replace
23 the current load limited and structurally deficient corrugated pipe bridge with a precast box
24 culvert; and

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26 WHEREAS, following the distribution of four bid packets and review of two bids
27 received, the Executive has proposed entering into a construction contract with Kenmore
28 Construction Co., Inc. for the Project, located in Bath Township, in Council District 4, in an
29 amount not to exceed \$583,862.52; and

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31 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on June 22, 2022, awarded a
32 construction contract with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc., as the lowest responsive and
33 responsible bidder, for the Project, located in Bath Township, in Council District 4, in an amount
34 not to exceed \$583,862.52, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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36 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
37 that the aforementioned construction contract with Kenmore Construction Co., Inc. for the
38 Project is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
41 of Ohio, that:

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43 SECTION 1

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45 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Kenmore Construction
46 Co., Inc. for the Revere Road Bridge Design/Build Project, located in Bath Township, in Council
47 District 4, in an amount not to exceed \$583,862.52, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is
48 hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related
49 documents.

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
7 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
8 authorize a necessary construction contract for the rehabilitation of the structurally deficient
9 Revere Road Bridge.

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13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
15 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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17 SECTION 4

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19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
22 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
23 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
