Market Street, in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, is a 56,000 square foot building that houses the Summit County Artspace. It was built in 1928 and was last renovated in 2008 with plumbing, HVAC and electrical improvements; and WHEREAS, the intent of the Summit Center Improvement Project (the "Project") is to expand on the previous improvements with additional mechanical, electrical, plumbing and architectural upgrades which will provide for better client and employee comfort and safety with HVAC, lighting and exterior door improvements; and		
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22 23 24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, after issuing a Request for Proposals and receiving five proposals, the Executive selected Four Points Architectural Services, Inc. as the most qualified firm to provide design services for the Project; and		
28 29	WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on July 6, 2022, awarded a professional service contract with Four Points Architectural Services, Inc. for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$90,700.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and		
30 31 32 33	WHEREAS, it is expected that the cost of the Project, including design services, will be reimbursed through the issuance of general obligation bonds at a future date; and		
34 35 36 37 38	WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution 2022-206, which authorized the issuance and sales of bonds in the aggregate maximum principal amount of \$1,200,000, for the purpose of paying the costs of the acquisition, construction, installation and equipping of improvements for the Project; and		
39 40 41	WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned professional service contract with Four Points Architectural Services, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

48 49 50 51	The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Four Points Architectural Services, Inc. for design services for the Summit Center Improvement Project, in an amount not to exceed \$90,700.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.		

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SECTION 2

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This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"): This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the design, replacement and construction of the Summit Center Improvement Project will be reimbursed with the proceeds of bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this section 2 is not to exceed \$1,200,000.00.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes a necessary professional service design contract for the Summit Center Improvement Project so that it may proceed in a timely fashion.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

INTRODUCED

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
