7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the**
8 **State Fiscal Year 2022 Hazard Mitigation Program Grant, in the amount not to exceed**
9 **\$25,000.00, with a 10% local cash match, for the Executive's Department of Public Safety,**
10 **Emergency Management Agency, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program is available to help develop, and update
13 hazard mitigation plans to ensure that counties remain eligible for Federal Emergency
14 Management Agency ("FEMA") Hazard Mitigation Assistance Program funds; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Hazard Mitigation Program Grant ("HMPG") funds made available as the
17 result of the COVID-19 disaster declaration (DR-4507) on March 31, 2020, now require cost
18 sharing, with the federal cost share to be 90% and the required local cost share to be 10%; and

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20 WHEREAS, the County is eligible for the 2022 HMPG, as provided for in the Ohio
21 Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA") Grant Program guidelines to pay for expenses related
22 to the planning and review process; and

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24 WHEREAS, the County must adopt a resolution to accept said grant; and

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26 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a Grant Agreement with OEMA in
27 substantially the same form presented to the Executive to receive the HMGP Grant; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
30 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
31 execute any documents necessary to accept the State Fiscal Year 2022 HMPG from OEMA, in the
32 amount not to exceed \$25,000.00, with a 10% local cash match requirement for hazard mitigation
33 planning and review processes.

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35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
36 of Ohio, that:

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38 SECTION 1

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40 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept the State
41 Fiscal Year 2022 HMPG from OEMA, in the amount not to exceed \$25,000.00, with a 10% cost
42 share local cash match requirement for hazard mitigation planning and review processes.

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46 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare
47 of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing
48 the acceptance of grant funds to support hazard mitigation projects in Summit County.
