## SECTION 1

The month of September 2022 is hereby declared Recovery Month in Summit County and the residents of Summit County are hereby encouraged to join in this acknowledgement.

## **SECTION 2**

The resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and further to immediately declare September 2022 as Recovery Month in Summit County prior to the commencement of the month.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**
