A Resolution creating the voluntary Summit County Gun Buyback and Safety Training Initiative, authorizing the Sheriff to facilitate a gun buyback event, and authorizing the Executive to procure up to \$55,000.00 of gift cards, gun locks, educational materials, advertising and other related event expenses, for the Executive, Sheriff and Councilmembers Sims, Schmidt and Dickinson and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, there has been a nationwide surge in significant cases of gun violence in the United States with 2,000 incidents in June of 2022 alone resulting in 877 deaths (as reported by the Gun Violence Archives a not for profit corporation formed in 2013 to provide free online public access to accurate information about gun-related violence in the United States); and

WHEREAS, in the State of Ohio there have been 779 deaths over the past year with 41 of those occurring in Summit County (as reported by the Gun Violence Archives); and

WHEREAS, members of this Council, the Executive and the Sheriff have worked to create a voluntary Gun Buyback and Safety Training Initiative in Summit County, comprised of a gun buyback program, safety lock giveaway, and educational programs and materials that include legal updates on new laws and gun safety; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to create the voluntary Summit County Gun Buyback and Safety Training Initiative and to authorize the Executive and the Sheriff to facilitate a gun buyback event; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

### SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to procure up to \$55,000.00 of gift cards, gun locks, safety devices, educational materials, advertising, and other related program expenses for the voluntary Summit County Gun Buyback and Safety Training Initiative.

## **SECTION 2**

The Sheriff is hereby authorized to facilitate a gun buyback event and to establish procedures for securing and providing gift cards and safety locks and securing and disposing of guns and providing training subject matter and materials to participants.

#### **SECTION 3**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately allow for a voluntary Program to help address responsible gun ownership in Summit County.
