A Resolution declaring the week of October 16 <sup>th</sup> -22 <sup>nd</sup> , 2022 as Stormwater Awareness Week in Summit County, recognizing the effects of stormwater runoff on the infrastructure and environment, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.
WHEREAS, according to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), stormwater runoff is generated when rain and snowmelt flows over land or impervious surfaces, such as paved streets, parking lots, and building rooftops, and does not soak into the ground; and
WHEREAS, stormwater runoff flows off these surfaces and into streams, lakes, and groundwater, sometimes depositing pollutants into these waters, affecting water quality; and
WHEREAS, as communities grow, develop, and change, so to do their landscapes, which further affects stormwater quantity and quality throughout Summit County and Ohio; and
WHEREAS, these impacts cannot be avoided or eliminated in their entirety, but can be minimized; and
WHEREAS, stormwater management is most effective when residents and organizations understand the causes and consequences of polluted stormwater runoff and flooding and the actions they can take to control them; and
WHEREAS, the need for residents to be informed and engaged on the preservation of their community and the regulatory requirements of EPA General Construction and Municipal Stormwater rules necessitates annual efforts to increase awareness about stormwater runoff and management; and
WHEREAS, the development of effective stormwater management is crucial to delivering an environment that meets federal standards on stormwater pollution control and protects and preserves the waterways and water quality of the 31 communities in Summit County;
WHEREAS, the State of Ohio and Summit County have observed Stormwater Awareness Week annually to raise awareness around stormwater runoff and its effects; and
WHEREAS, Summit County is investing in stormwater management through \$18.8 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding and coordination through the Surface Water Management District containing 13 of our communities; and
WHEREAS, Summit County remains committed to engaging residents in the effective management of stormwater runoff to preserve the environment and ensure Summit County remains an incredible place for people to live, work, and play; and
WHEREAS, residents can get involved by educating themselves on the effects of runoff in their community, implement landscaping that prevents erosion and promotes native plants, and promote private and public development that accounts for stormwater management and minimizes negative environmental impacts; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit and its residents that the week of October 16<sup>th</sup>–22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 be declared Stormwater Awareness Week in Summit County, recognizing the effects of stormwater runoff on the infrastructure and environment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The week of October 16<sup>th</sup>–22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 is hereby declared Stormwater Awareness Week in Summit County, and the residents of Summit County are encouraged to join in this acknowledgement.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents and employees of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of declaring October 16<sup>th</sup>–22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022 to be Stormwater Awareness Week in Summit County.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
