WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to advertise for bids for the Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$673,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the Combined Dispatch Center Tower Project to construct a of a 165 foot tower and communications shelter to support the shared 911 call center, located in the City of Tallmadge, in Council District 6, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$673,000.00.

SECTION 2

This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"): This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the Combined Dispatch Building Project to construct a shared 911 call center including the installation of a 165 foot tower and communications shelter will be reimbursed with the proceeds of bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this section 2 is not to exceed \$20,000,000.00.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive to immediately advertisement for bids so that the necessary construction of a tower for the shared 911 system building in Summit County may commence as expeditiously as possible.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
