Summit County, et al.*, Case No. 5-21-cv-01638-SL, before Judge Sara Lioi in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio (the "Lawsuit"); and

WHEREAS, additional legal representation and services by Roetzel & Andress, LPA are necessary to defend the Lawsuit; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 7, 2022, awarded Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned professional service contract with Roetzel & Andress, LPA, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 133.33%), for a total amount of \$175,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to said professional service contract with Roetzel & Andress, LPA to provide legal representation and services in the Lawsuit, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1
