7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the**
8 **Information Technology Board, of a purchase contract with Tek84 Inc of one Intercept**
9 **Whole Body Security Scanning System for use at the Jail, as an emergency purchase**
10 **pursuant to Cod. Ord. section 177.07(a)(3), in an amount not to exceed \$179,500.00, for the**
11 **Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the current Jail scanner is inoperable and the warranty has expired; and

15 WHEREAS, the Sheriff, having evaluated other alternatives wishes to purchase a Tek84
16 Inc. Intercept Whole Body Security Scanning System as it is smaller than other full body
17 scanners making it less intrusive in the Jail Intake area and utilizes the most advanced
18 technology resulting in the best imaging compared to competitors to help prevent contraband
19 from entering the Jail; and

21 WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County
22 of Summit, replacing the inoperable scanner with new equipment is necessary as an emergency
23 due to the need to protect deputies, civilian staff and other inmates from the introduction of
24 contraband into the jail; and

26 WHEREAS, this purchase contract includes in-house training on the Intercept Whole
27 Body Security Scanning System and five years of maintenance for said system; and

28
29 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its meeting to be held on October 13,
30 2022, will consider the aforementioned purchase contract with Tek84 Inc.; and

32 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 28, 2022, awarded a
33 purchase contract with Tek84 Inc., as an emergency, for the purchase of one Intercept Whole
34 Body Security Scanning System for use at the Jail, in an amount not to exceed \$179,500.00,
35 subject to confirmation by the Information Technology Board and this Council; and

37 WHEREAS, Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information that
38 the aforementioned purchase contract with Tek84 Inc. as an emergency is necessary and in the
39 best interest of the County of Summit;

41 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
42 of Ohio, that:

46 Subject to approval by the Information Technology Board, the award by the Board of
47 Control of a purchase contract with Tek84 Inc. for the purchase of one Intercept Whole Body
48 Security Scanning System for use at the Jail, in an amount not to exceed \$179,500.00, as an
49 emergency pursuant to section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances, is hereby confirmed and
50 the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any necessary related
51 documents.
