11 12 13	WHEREAS, the United States Small Business Administration ("SBA") has cosponsored Small Business Saturday since 2011; and
14 15 16 17	WHEREAS, Small Business Saturday is meant to celebrate small businesses and their contributions to their local communities, and provide small businesses with marketing materials, industry insights, and discounts on tools and services; and
18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has negatively impacted small businesses such as restaurants, bakeries, salons, boutiques, theaters, stadiums, construction firms, dentist offices, retain stores, and more, as well as their employees and suppliers; and
22 23 24	WHEREAS, the United States government and Summit County have both deployed financial relief to small businesses and their employees, with Summit County alone distributing \$12.8 million in CARES Act funding to 3,000 small businesses; and
25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, the 2021 Consumer Insights Survey reported an estimated \$23.3 billion in spending on Small Business Saturday in the United States; and
29 30 31 32	WHEREAS, this number represents both an increase over 2020, at \$19.8 billion, and over 2019, at \$19.6 billion, indicating that efforts to support small businesses may be encouraging a recovery from the height of the pandemic; and
33 34 35 36	WHEREAS, 79% of shoppers recognized the importance of shopping small to support their community, indicating that people understand that positive impact of small businesses on local economies; and
37 38 39	WHEREAS, the Executive and Council wish to share in this celebration and support local small businesses as transition through the economic recovery and beyond; and
40 41 42	WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to declare November 26, 2022, as Small Business Saturday in Summit County and to encourage the residents of Summit County to support local small businesses;

SECTION 1

The day of November 26, 2022 is hereby declared Small Business Saturday in Summit County, and the resident of Summit County are encouraged to support local small businesses.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately spread awareness for Small Business Saturday prior to November 26, 2022.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight (8) members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
