A Resolution authorizing the Executive and Sheriff to execute a Mobile Field Force Mu		

A Resolution authorizing the Executive and Sheriff to execute a Mobile Field Force Multi-Jurisdiction Operational Assistance Mutual Aid Agreement with other local law enforcement agencies, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 505.43 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes townships to enter into an agreement with a county sheriff to obtain additional police protection; and

WHEREAS, Section 737.04 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the legislative authority of a municipal corporation to allow contracts with one or more municipal corporations, townships and county sheriffs in order to obtain additional police protection; and

WHEREAS, Section 3345.041 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the board of trustees of a state university to enter into agreements with political subdivisions, including townships, municipal corporations and counties, to allow their officers to perform police functions on behalf of the contracting political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff operates a Mobile Field Force which has trained with several local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Executive and Sheriff wish to execute a Mutual Aid Agreement for Multi-Jurisdiction Operational Assistance in order to coordinate training, develop common standards and prepare for the utilization of Mobile Field Force Units, if necessary, in response to major spontaneous events or other emergency situations affecting the County; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive and Sheriff to execute the aforementioned Mutual Aid Agreement with the agencies listed below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive and Sheriff are hereby authorized to execute a Mutual Aid Agreement with the Township of Bath, the City of Fairlawn, the City of Cuyahoga Falls, the Township of Copley, the Village of Richfield, the City of Hudson, the University of Akron, the City of Barberton, the City of Stow, the City of Tallmadge, the City of Akron, the City of Munroe Falls and/or their respective law enforcement agencies. The Executive and Sheriff are hereby authorized to execute said Mutual Aid Agreement in substantially the same form as attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said Mutual Aid Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive and the Sheriff. As stated in the Agreement, additional

parties may enter into the Agreement and a party may cease to participate at any time.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the Executive and Sheriff to execute any documents necessary for the aforesaid Mutual Aid Agreement.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
