7 **A Resolution declaring the failure in the Little Cuyahoga trunk sewer caused by severe**  
8 **blockages near the intersection of Mogadore Road and Skelton Road, located in the City of**  
9 **Akron, in Council District 8, an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified**  
10 **Ordinances of the County of Summit, and confirming the award by the Board of Control of**  
11 **a construction contract with Wingfoot Rental & Development Co., in an amount not to**  
12 **exceed \$312,801.56, for an emergency repair to the trunk sewer, for the Executive's**  
13 **Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, due to the failure in the Little Cuyahoga trunk sewer, emergency repairs  
16 were required to remove severe blockages in the 24 inch diameter trunk sewer and replace the  
17 damaged trunk sewer near the intersection of Mogadore Road and Skelton Road in Akron; and

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19 WHEREAS, Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. was directed to make the emergency  
20 repairs based on their expertise, availability and performance on similar projects; and

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22 WHEREAS, the above referenced circumstances made it necessary for the County to  
23 utilize Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. for an emergency repair of the Little Cuyahoga  
24 trunk sewer near the intersection of Mogadore Road and Skelton Road in Akron to be returned to  
25 normal operations; and

27 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on October 19, 2022, awarded a  
28 construction contract with Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. for an emergency repair of said  
29 trunk sewer, in an amount not to exceed \$312,801.56, subject to confirmation by this Council;

32 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
33 that the aforementioned repairs constitute an emergency repair under Section 177.07(a)(3) of the  
34 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and further finds and determines that it is  
35 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to confirm the award by the Board of  
36 Control of a construction contract with Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. for said emergency  
37 repair of the trunk sewer, in an amount not to exceed \$312,801.56;

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39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
40 of Ohio, that:

42 SECTION 1

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44 This Council finds and determines that the repair of the Little Cuyahoga trunk sewer near  
45 the intersection of Mogadore Road and Skelton Road, located in the City of Akron, in Council  
46 District 8, is an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinance of the  
47 County of Summit.

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SECTION 2

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. for an emergency repair of the Little Cuyahoga trunk sewer near the intersection of Mogadore Road and Skelton Road, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$312,801.56 is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize a necessary construction contract with Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. for an emergency repair of the trunk sewer near the intersection of Mogadore Road and Skelton Road, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 8.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


