18 19	WHEREAS, the Project's estimated cost is \$903,000.00; and
20 21	WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration monies have been awarded to the Engineer's office for a grant to cover 80% of the Project, with Bath Township providing the 20% local cash match; and
22 23 24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") and the Executive and Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreement, to confirm the Project's Cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of the Project; and

50 51 52	The terms of said agreement shall include the following:

## SECTION 2 (Continued)

- a. That the parties estimate the Project's Cost to be \$903,000.00;
- b. That LPA shall provide \$700,000.00 in Federal Safety funds with a local match of \$203,000.00 from Bath Township funds;
- c. Bath Township shall provide all other financial resources necessary to fully complete the Project; and
- d. That, upon receipt of federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Project, with award of the Project subject to applicable County of Summit Ordinances, said ordinances requiring authorization of such an award by the Board of Control.

## **SECTION 3**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it completes a prerequisite to accept funds needed for safe and convenient travel within the County.

## **SECTION 4**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 5**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
