7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Summa Health, as a Best Practical Source, for the Valor Court Expansion**
9 **and Enhancement Project for the period 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in an amount not to**
10 **exceed \$117,952.00, funded by a Fiscal Year 2023 Drug Treatment Courts grant from the**
11 **Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, for the Court of Common**
12 **Pleas-General Division, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Substance
15 Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (“SAMHSA”) has awarded to the Court of
16 Common Pleas-General Division Valor Court, a Fiscal Year 2023 Treatment Drug Courts grant,
17 for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project, in the amount of \$117,952.00, with no
18 local cash match requirement, for the period 9/30/22 through 9/29/23; and

20 WHEREAS, this SAMHSA grant has a grant period of 9/30/18 through 9/29/23, for a
21 total award of \$1,813,193.00, which is subject to performance review; and

23 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-050, which confirmed
24 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Summa Health, as a
25 Best Practical Source, for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project for the project
26 period 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$77,952.00, funded by Fiscal Year
27 2020 Drug Treatment Courts grant from SAMHSA; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-016, which
30 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Summa
31 Health, as a Best Practical Source, for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project for
32 the period 9/30/20 through 9/29/21, in an amount not to exceed \$77,952.00, funded by a Fiscal
33 Year 2021 Drug Treatment Courts grant from the SAMHSA; and

35 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted amended Resolution No. 2022-099,
36 which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with
37 Summa Health, as a Best Practical Source, for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement
38 Project for the period 9/30/21 through 9/29/22, in an amount not to exceed \$117,952.00, funded
39 by a Fiscal Year 2022 Drug Treatment Courts grant from the SAMHSA; and

41 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a contract with Summa Health which is a
42 Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified
43 Ordinances of the County of Summit due to their long time collaboration with and knowledge of
44 the Valor Court program, for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project for the period
45 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, to continue to provide a Dual Diagnosis Support Group and other
46 mental health services and support groups for the Project; and

48 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 16, 2022, awarded a
49 professional service contract with Summa Health, as a Best Practical Source, for the Valor Court
50 Expansion and Enhancement Project for the project period 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in an
51 amount not to exceed \$117,952.00, funded by a Fiscal Year 2023 Drug Treatment Courts grant
52 from SAMHSA, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

4 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the
5 aforementioned professional service contract with Summa Health is necessary and in the best
6 interest of the County of Summit;

13 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Summa
14 Health, as a Best Practical Source, for the Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project for
15 the project period 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in an amount not to exceed \$117,952.00, funded by a
16 Fiscal Year 2023 Drug Treatment Courts grant from the Department of Health and Human
17 Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, is hereby confirmed and
18 the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any other
19 necessary related documents.

23 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
24 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
25 expend funds within grant guidelines and provide services through Summa Health for the Valor
26 Court Expansion and Enhancement Project, for the period 9/30/22 through 9/29/23.

30 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
31 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
32 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
