A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a grant agreement with the State of Ohio Emergency Management Agency, through the Hazard Mitigation Block Grant Program, for implementing flood mitigation, erosion control and bank stabilization improvements for the Wye Road Flood Mitigation Project within the Sanctuary of Bath neighborhood, located in Bath Township, in Council District 5, with the grant award not to exceed \$375,257.20, with a local cash match of \$40,000.00, for the Executive and Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Engineer applied for Hazard Mitigation Block Grant Program funds, provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency to the State of Ohio Emergency Management Agency, for which the County of Summit will be the sub-recipient of grant funds, for the Wye Road Flood Mitigation Project (the "Project"), which will implement flood mitigation, erosion control and bank stabilization improvement to the Wye Creek storm system within the Sanctuary of Bath neighborhood, located in Bath Township, in Council District 5; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Emergency Management Agency has awarded \$375,257.20 towards the Project, subject to a Resolution by this Council authorizing the Executive to enter into the agreement to accept said funds and appointing the Engineer's Office the agency responsible for implementing the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to execute a grant agreement to move forward the Project, which is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to enter into a grant agreement for the aforementioned Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

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50 51 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other necessary related documents with the State of Ohio Emergency Management Agency, through the Hazard Mitigation Block Grant Program, for implementing flood mitigation, erosion control and bank stabilization improvements to the Wye Creek storm system for the Wye Road Flood Mitigation Project (the "Project"), within the Sanctuary of Bath neighborhood, located in Bath Township, in Council District 5, with the grant award not to exceed \$375,257.20, with a local cash match of \$40,000.00. The final agreement will be substantially in the form of the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said grant agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive.
