A Resolution authorizing the Executive to apply for and execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan agreement for the Q-178 Aurora Shores Waste Water Treatment Plant No. 29 Abandonment Project, located in the Village of Reminderville, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$1,033,103.89, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-333, which authorized the Executive to execute a sanitary sewer service agreement with the City of Twinsburg in which the County would abandon Waste Water Treatment Plant ("WWTP") No. 29 due to age and necessary capital improvements, and purchase 650,000 gallons per day capacity at the Twinsburg WWTP to send sanitary sewer flow from the Reminderville Service Area to Twinsburg for treatment and disposal, located in the City of Twinsburg, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000.00; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-106 to authorize the County Executive to apply for and execute a loan agreement with the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF"), through the Ohio Water Development Authority ("OWDA"), to finance the Q-178 Aurora Shores Waste Water Treatment Plant No. 29 Abandonment Project (the "Project"), located in the Village of Reminderville, in Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$2,589,246.80; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-130 to authorize the Executive to apply for and execute a supplemental loan agreement with the WPCLF, through the OWDA, to fund the Project in an amount not to exceed \$1,900,000.00; and

WHEREAS, WPCLF requires the legislative authority of the County to adopt legislation for the application of loans, the execution of agreements and the designation of repayment sources; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to apply for and execute the WPCLF loan and designate repayment from the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

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50 51 52 The Executive is hereby authorized to apply for and execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan, through the Ohio Water Development Authority, to finance the Q-178 Aurora Shores Waste Water Treatment Plant No. 29 Abandonment Project, in an amount not to exceed \$1,033,103.89 and any other necessary documents related to the loan. This Council further designates the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund as the dedicated source of repayment for the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately execute a necessary loan document so that the Project may proceed in a timely manner.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
