A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Black Horse Bridge Construction, Inc., to replace the bridge on Pressler Road approximately 0.2 miles south of Killian Road, located in Springfield Township, in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$932,941.50, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.
