WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2019-332 and 2019-361, this Council authorized the Executive to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding settlement agreements, in litigation titled In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation, Case No. 1:17-MD-2804, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio (the "Lawsuit"), resulting in an unprecedented amount of settlements; and

changes within county agencies to implement trauma informed care for a one-year period,

with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, for the Executive, and declaring

WHEREAS, the Executive convened the Key Stakeholders Group and the Opiate Abatement Advisory Council ("OAAC") to help determine how to spend the opiate money to best serve the residents of the County; and

WHEREAS, the OAAC made a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to receive proposals to complete an assessment of the current System and, working with the Trauma Informed Care Coalition and Change Direction Summit County to create recommendations for a countywide trauma informed care strategic plan including input from public, private and faith-based system participants; and

WHEREAS, the University of Akron submitted the response that best met the requirements of the RFP; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Board will be providing half of the funding for this endeavor; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute a grant agreement with the University of Akron for the aforementioned project in an amount not to exceed \$272,527.00, for a one-year period, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term, to be paid from settlement dollars received by the County in the Lawsuit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
