SECTION 1

This Council hereby finds and determines, pursuant to Section 177.18(e) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, that good cause exists and that a public auction or sealed bid is not warranted for the disposal by the Executive of the Election System and Software ("ES&S") voting equipment, excluding three ES&S 850 high-speed scanners. The Executive is hereby authorized, pursuant to Sections 177.18(b)(2) and (e) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit to dispose of the remaining voting equipment.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Summit County, and for the further purpose of immediately authorizing the Executive to dispose of certain ES&S voting equipment so that the Board of Elections may have adequate storage space for the new voting equipment.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
