WHEREAS, BeInCourt has agreed to replace all of the monitors purchased under the project, at no cost, as part of the execution of a one-year maintenance agreement, which includes on-site support, for the term of 7/1/23 through 6/30/24, for a total cost not to exceed \$345,142.32, with an option to renew for an additional one-year term; and

WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its meeting to be held on February 16, 2023, will consider the aforementioned purchase contract with BeInCourt; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 8, 2023, awarded the aforementioned purchase contract with BeInCourt, subject to the approval by the Information Technology Board and confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned purchase contract with BeInCourt, subject to approval of the Information Technology Board, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
