SECTION 2

 The existing pay/salary schedule tables for non-bargaining classified and unclassified employees of the Council, Executive, Fiscal Officer, Prosecutor, Sheriff, Clerk of Courts, Engineer, Internal Audit Department, Office of Information Technology, and Human Resource Commission shall be increased by 4% effective April 1, 2023, as stated in the pay/salary schedule tables, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated. Effective April 1, 2023, the pay/salary schedule tables in Exhibit A shall replace existing pay/salary schedule tables and shall remain in effect for the remainder of calendar year 2023 and thereafter.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason of immediately authorizing the aforementioned 4% salary increase and adjustment to the pay/salary schedule tables so that it may be effective April 1, 2023, and in order to maintain pay equity and competitiveness in employment within the County, subject to the aforementioned future contingency.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
