A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Perrin Asphalt & Concrete for the 2023 Summit County Regional Concrete Pavement Repair Program, in an amount not to exceed \$648,670.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-370, which authorized the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2023 Capital Improvements Program, and federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$13,962,800.00; and

WHEREAS, this Program was approved by this Council as part of the Capital Improvements Program for 2023-2028 by Resolution 2023-025; and

WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive proposes entering into a construction contract with Perrin Asphalt & Concrete for the 2023 Summit County Regional Concrete Pavement Repair Program, in an amount not to exceed \$648,670.00; and

WHEREAS, the proposed work to be performed by Perrin Asphalt & Concrete will consist of saw cutting as needed, removing concrete slabs and pouring new concrete for County, Bath Township, Copley Township, Lakemore, Sagamore Hills Township and Twinsburg Township; and

WHEREAS, the contract total in an amount not to exceed \$648,670.00 will be broken down by political subdivision as follows with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

County share: None

Bath Township: \$209,150.00 Copley Township: \$234,200.00

Lakemore: \$55,520.00

Sagamore Hills Township: \$115,875.00 Twinsburg Township: \$33,925.00

and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 22, 2023, awarded a construction contract with Perrin Asphalt & Concrete, as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the 2023 Summit County Regional Concrete Pavement Repair Program, in an amount not to exceed \$648,670.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that aforementioned construction contract with Perrin Asphalt & Concrete is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Perrin Asphalt & Concrete, as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the 2023 Summit County Regional Concrete Pavement Repair Program, in an amount not to exceed \$648,670.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately provide a necessary construction contract for the 2023 Summit County Regional Concrete Pavement Repair Program.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
